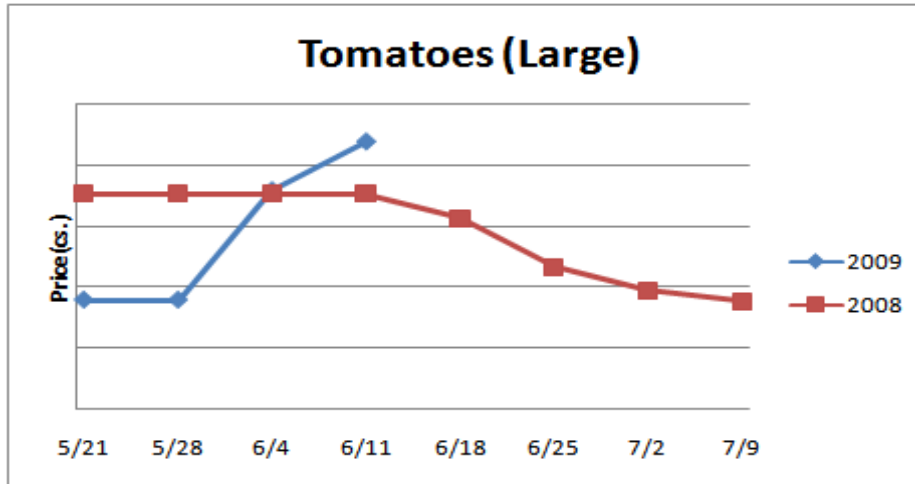


# Produce Report

**Produce-** The tomato markets continue to trade at inflated levels as both eastern and western harvest areas are in a state of transition. Due to a relatively wet spring, the eastern tomato harvest could be short in the coming weeks which may cause erratic tomato prices to persist. Various Idaho potato markets have turned upward as storage supplies dwindle. The 70 count Idaho potato shipping point market typically moves 11% higher during the next 4 weeks. Idaho potato prices may turn lower in August. Onion supplies are limited. The onion markets may be elevated throughout June.
