### **striped bass (rockfish)**

Raw material pricing has dropped, and fish are plentiful as commercial seasons are opening in other states along the East Coast; as the fish migrate.



### **blue crab**

The season has started, and prices are high. Look for prices to stay up until the weather fully breaks. Cold weather has slowed down the early crabbing season.



### **venezuelan crabmeat**

Pricing seems to be stabilizing. Demand is high as restaurants trust crabmeat pricing, and more dishes are beginning to show back up on menus.



### **blue catfish**

Pricing is consistent but expensive. Fuel prices are a driving factor in raw material costs.



### **mahi mahi**

Raw material costing is starting to drop as the product becomes more available.



### **sword**

Raw material costs stay high—spotty availability in the marketplace.



### **halibut**

Raw material costs are stabilizing as fishing has significantly increased.



### **scallops (seatrade)**

Prices are dropping as more catch areas have opened.

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## H&G tuna

Raw material landings are high. Local, long-line boats should start landing local fish as the weather breaks.



## chilean seabass

Refresh product Falkland Islands. Deepwater long-line caught. FAS - Frozen at Sea. Supply is steady, and the market is continuing to trend upward.



## shellfish

P.E.I. fresh mussels special. Every customer should have a bag. Oyster variety- Sweet Jesus, Salt Shakers, Bay Shore, De. Blue Point, Watch House Point, and Chesapeake Gold.



## shrimp

Prices on the large sizes continue to be tight. Prices of mid to small are harder to find.



## cod (STP free/no tripoli)

All long-line caught Pacific cod. Price remains high but steady.



## lobster (live)

Lobster pricing back down to reality. Raw material plentiful in the marketplace.



## trout

From the mountains of Carolina. Farm-raised. Availability is tight. 8 oz fillet (bones removed) and 10 oz whole head-on boned (meaning bones out).



## bronzini

COO: Mixture of Turkey and Spain. 600/800 g. Butterfly, S&G, or fillet. Fillets 4-7 oz roughly.



## chilean salmon

Pricing continues to stay in line with the European and Canadian suppliers and is dropping.



## canadian salmon

Raw material costs are beginning to drop from an all-time high. Low harvest and high demand.



## faroe salmon

High but consistent pricing. Bakkafrost continues to be the brand of choice.



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
